TERMS

Please read this information carefully and keep it for your records.

By enrolling your camper with us you agree to the following:

INCLUSIONS

Tuition includes room and board, instruction in all activities, linen service, laundry, transportation from Dulles Airport and select cities, horseback riding and counselor gratuities. No tipping allowed.

A sibling discount of \$100 per additional child per session can be applied, although this offer cannot be combined with early enrollment discounts.

MISCELLANEOUS

In order for campers to be easily identified on any camp trips, a camp t-shirt is required. A variety of Camp logo clothing can be purchased at the online camp store.

Campers are not permitted to have cell phones in camp. Cell phones will be shipped home at parents' expense.

I/We grant camp permission to open any package sent to camp to ensure that it is deemed appropriate for camp and in accordance with the camp policies. Perishable items sent to camp will be discarded.

It is understood that the camp has the right to use whatever pictures may be taken at camp for the purposes of promoting camper enrollment and/or in advertising the camp.

Camp is not responsible for personal property lost or misplaced at or in the route to or from camp as well as the containers in which they are sent.

PAYMENT

Make all checks payable to Camp Tall Timbers, Inc. Camp tuition is payable as follows: **\$500.00 deposit with the enrollment agreement, \$1000.00 due February 1,** and the **balance is due by May 1.** All monies are refundable until March 1, less \$250 registration fee. Any unpaid tuition after May 1 will be subject to a 1.5% per month finance charge on the unpaid balance. Camp tuition and deposits are not refundable in any situation, including but not limited to those situations when the camper is asked to leave camp for disciplinary reasons. No refunds of tuition are made for partial camp sessions.

Not included in tuition will be luggage shipment, airfare for those using airlines, West Virginia sales tax and a refundable spending account of \$25.00 per week.

MEDICAL

I/We acknowledge that the camp does not maintain any health or other medical insurance which would cover the camper while attending the camp. We will be responsible for the costs of all medical treatment, drugs and the like provided to our child during the camping season. We agree to carry medical insurance covering our child while attending the Camp and we will provide our health insurance information which you may provide to third parties in connection with any medical treatment provided to our child during the camping season.

In case of a medical emergency, I understand every effort will be made to contact parent or guardian of the camper. If I cannot be reached, I hereby give permission to the Physician selected by the Camp Director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injection, anesthesia or surgery for my child. I further assign all medical payments directly to said Doctor and/or treating facility.

My/Our child has permission to participate in all activities while at camp this summer. I agree that the Camp will not be responsible for any injuries that may be sustained by my child while participating in any activity at Camp unless such injury is directly caused by the gross negligence or willful acts of the Camp.
